Project Information

Construction will begin October 2020 on the WIS 23 bridge across the Wisconsin River between Iowa and Sauk County. During construction, the bridge deck will be replaced.

The bridge and portions of the river under the bridge will be a work zone during construction. The river will remain open to boaters, but some portions will be restricted for your protection. Please be alert for crews working and use caution when navigating this area. Use buoys to guide your navigation through the work zone for your safety.

Boater Guide

- Follow navigational buoys placed in the river. **Stay between the red and green buoys.**
- This area is a **SLOW NO WAKE zone.**
- Boating is restricted in areas during construction for safety. The buoys will be relocated periodically as construction progresses.
